



Anniversary Brag Wallet

My Wallet Style Mini Brag Book Wallet https://youtu.be/oWP4Vs_YtAY was the first step by step video tutorial I did on YouTube. This was now 3 years ago now and as a way of a Big Thank you to you my YouTube subscribers I have designed an Anniversary Brag Book Wallet.

I do hope you enjoy making it as much as my first ever project.

Supplies:

- 3 sheets of 12x12 cardstock
- paper to decorate (you can use scraps left from a previous project)
- Embellishments to decorate - optional

Tools:

- Paper Trimmer
- Scoreboard
- Wet Glue
- Scissors
- 4 x magnets <http://www.first4magnets.com/circular-disc-rod-magnets-c34/10mm-dia-x-1mm-thick-n42-neodymium-magnet-0-58kg-pull-p2818>

Construction

- Get one sheet of 12x12 cardstock and score @ 2", 2 1/2", 9 1/2" & 10 "
- Now do one turn and score @ 3", 3 1/2", 7 3/4" & 8 1/4"
- Now cut the cardstock as I show you in the video
- Next burnish the score lines along with me as I do in the video.

Bottom Flaps:

- Get another sheet of card and cut 2 pieces that measure 6 3/4" x 3 3/4".
- also cut 6 3/4" x 4 1/2"
- Punch a half circle if you wish to create an opening to your pockets
- Now using wet glue attach the 2 pieces (6 3/4" x 3 3/4")
- Get the card measuring 6 3/4" x 4 1/2" and on the short side score a line at 4".
- Using wet glue stick this on the gusset and also stick down the 2 side little tabs.

Top Flap

- Now create the diagonal pockets as I do on the video and attach 2 of your magnets one on each side.
- You can then glue your 2 diagonal pockets.

- Take another sheet of 12 x12 cardstock and cut 1 @ 6 3/4" x 4 1/2"
- Then cut 2 @ 6 3/3" x 3 3/4"
- Then on all on them on the short side score in at 1/2"
- Burnish all the scorelines.
- Take the 4 1/2" using wet glue stick this on the gusset and also stick down the 2 side little tabs.
- Then glue the other 2 as a waterfall affect on the back of the project.

Side Flaps

- Cut 2 @ 6" x 4"
- score these on the long side @ 3 " and 3 1/4"
- Burnish the score lines
- Glue 1 to each side, sticking them to the middle of the side gussets.
- Now attach your final 2 magnetic to the cover of your project before we decorate with patterned papers.

Paper to Decorate

Cover

- 1 @ 6 3/4" x 3 1/2"
- 1 @ 6 3/4" x 2 1/2"
- 1 @ 6 3/4" x 4"

- 2 @ 6 3/4" x 3/8"
- 2 @ 4" x 3/8"

Bottom Flaps

- 3 @ 6 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 2 @ 3 1/2" x 2 1/4"
- 2 @ 3 1/2" x 4"

Strips to cover inside gussets

- 2 @ 6 3/4" x 3/8"

Top Pocket

- 1 @ 2 1/2" x 6 3/4"
- 2 @ 2 1/4" x 2 3/4" these need cutting to fit the diagonal pockets

Inside Middle Flaps

- 4 @ 6 1/2" x 3 3/4"
- 4 @ 6 1/2" x 3"
- 1 @ 6 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Sides

- 4 @ 4" x 2 3/4"
- 4 @ 4" x 2 1/2"
- 4 @ 4" x 1 7/8"

Using the cardstock you have left you can make up tags, photo mats and little booklets to add to the pockets of your project.
